\*\* Courses/programs equivalent to 6 credits of First Year English include the following:

- the Arts One Program, **or** the Coordinated Arts Program's 6-credit ASTU 100A; **or**
- ASTU 100B (3 credits) plus 3 credits of First Year English; **or**
- ASTU 150 / WRDS 150 (3 credits) plus 3 credits of First Year English.

Students who receive UBC English credit for **Advanced Placement (AP) or International Baccalaureate (IB)** programs may count those credits toward the first-year English requirement for the Minor.

**Note:** Beginning September 2010, ENGL 330A (3.0) plus ENGL 331 (3.0) replace ENGL 329 (6.0). If you have not completed ENGL 329 prior to the 2010-11 Winter session, you must complete both 330A and 331 to meet Requirement (A) of the English Language Minor.

If you completed ENGL 329 prior to September 2010, you are not required to take ENGL 330A and 331.

**Courses outside the Department of English may not be counted towards the minor.**
