\*\* Courses/programs equivalent to 6 credits of First Year English include the following:

- the Arts One Program, **or** the Coordinated Arts Program's 6-credit ASTU 100A; **or**
- ASTU 100B (3 credits) plus 3 credits of First Year English; **or**
- ASTU 150 / WRDS 150 (3 credits) plus 3 credits of First Year English.

Students who receive UBC English credit for **Advanced Placement (AP) or International Baccalaureate (IB)** programs may count those credits toward the first-year English requirement for the Minor.

**Note:** Beginning September 2015, ENGL 318 (3.0) plus ENGL 319 (3.0) replace ENGL 320 (6.0). ENGL 318/319 cannot be taken for credit by students who have completed ENGL 320. Students who have taken ENGL 320 prior to September 2015 can count this course towards their English Language Minor.

**Courses outside the Department of English may not be counted towards the minor.**
